

Students are not required to buy a textbook for Virginia Practice this fall. We will be relying heavily on, and you must have access to, Title 8.01 (Vol. 2) and the Rules (Vol. 11) of the Code of Virginia. If you are like me and prefer to have a book in hand, you may purchase those volumes directly from LexisNexis or Matthew Bender & Company, Inc. However, if you are just as comfortable reviewing statutes online, you may access them that way instead. Many students do so without difficulty; it is purely a question of personal preference. If you wish to buy only one of the volumes, I suggest you purchase Title 8.01 and access the Rules online. We will also cover some statutes in other volumes of the Code, but those can easily be reviewed online.

With that in mind, I am revising the syllabus from last fall and it probably will not be ready until a week or two before the class starts. I will post it as soon as it is ready.
