Individual Attention

CAAS is committed to working with every law student and law graduate. Our relatively small student body makes it possible for us to get to know each of you individually and to work with you one-on-one. In fact, one-on-one CAAS sessions are required at George Mason during your first year. My staff and I will meet with you to (1) learn more about your background and experiences; (2) help you prepare your resume and cover letters; (3) explore suitable job opportunities; (4) prepare you for interviews in the job market; and (5) discuss course selections and the bar exam.

A Multitude of Opportunities for Practical Experience

By virtue of our location in metropolitan Washington, D.C., you will be faced with a multitude of career development opportunities, both during law school and ultimately upon graduation. As a student, you may choose to work for or complete an externship (employment for credit) with a federal or state court, law firm, corporation, government agency, or public interest organization. You may do an externship during the fall or spring semester after your first year or during a summer term. Our office has access to hundreds of paid and unpaid positions. In addition, our diverse clinical programs also offer the chance to earn credit and to gain practical experience while working on real cases for real clients, in judges’ chambers, or in the office of a public defender or state prosecutor.
