The clinic meets for two hours each week during the summer term but M-VETS student-advisors continue responsibility for the matters to which they have been assigned until the commencement of the fall 2017 semester.

(N.2) This course is being offered for 2 or 3 credits. Students registered for the 2 credit option (Section 001) will complete the course after nine class sessions. Students registered for the 3 credit option (Section 002) will complete the course after 14 class sessions.

(N.3) All students will register for a 2 credit option but may elect, after the first class and with the permission of the instructor, to increase to 3 credits.

The increase to 3 credits is contingent on the student being available to meet outside of the regularly scheduled class meeting time including, on occasion, at the courthouse in Manassas, Virginia.

(N.4) Information regarding the application process has been sent to all students via Law Career email. Enrollment with written permission of instructor.

(N.5) Students who took Unmanned Aerial Systems (Law 144) in Summer 2016 are not eligible to take Unmanned Aerial Systems Seminar (Law 647) because of an overlap in course coverage.
