(N.1) Information regarding the application process will be sent via LawNews email. The class meets for two hours a week but students receive three credits total given other assigned work and meetings outside of the regularly scheduled classroom time.

(N.2) This course will meet in the United States Bankruptcy Courthouse (200 South Washington Street) in Alexandria, VA on the 2nd and 4th Friday of each month, between 10:00 am and 1:00 pm, beginning in late August and continuing into early December.

(N.3) This course has been designated as a prerequisite for the Giles Rich Moot Court Competition (Law 125) scheduled for Spring 2019.

(N.4) This course is scheduled from 4:00 - 5:50 pm but, on occasion, will meet from 4:00 - 5:15 pm (on dates to be listed on the course syllabus).

(N.5) This course will be offered over two weekends, Oct. 19-21 and Nov. 16-18, meeting each weekend on Fridays (1:30-6:00P), Saturdays (8:00A-6:00P), and Sundays (8:00A-3:00P). Students **must** attend every session in order to receive credit for the course.

(N.6) Patent Law I & II will not be offered during the day in Academic Year 2018-2019. A 4 credit Patent Law course will be offered during the day in Spring 2019 instead (covering Patent Law I & II in one course). Students may choose to take either Patent Law I (Fall 2018) and Patent Law II (Spring 2019) in the evening, or Patent Law as a 4 cr course during the day in Spring 2019.

(N.7) This course will not meet weekly but will meet on assigned dates over the course of the semester as determined by the instructor.

(N.8) Approval to enroll in Law 320/321/520/521 must be granted prior to registration for the course. Approval forms must be submitted via Symplicity. Select Job Number 28432 in the Symplicity Job Bank and follow the instructions to complete the approval form. Students NOT being compensated for the work performed during their externship will register, upon approval, for Law 320 or 321. Students being compensated for the work performed during their externship will register, upon approval, for Law 520 or 521. Students are limited to a maximum of 6 credit hours of compensated externship credit and such credit may be earned only in a student's final two full semesters (fall or spring).

(N.9) Applications will be accepted via Symplicity. Application information was sent out via LawNews email. Students NOT being compensated for the work performed during their externship should register for Law 179, and students receiving compensation should register for Law 579. Students are limited to a maximum of 6 credit hours of compensated externship credit and such credit may be earned only in a student's final two full semesters (fall or spring). - (E) This course has been designated as an experiential course.
- + This course has prerequisites. **Please check course descriptions and syllabi for course prerequisite information.**

(N.1) This is a seven week course, ending mid-semester. It is open to all students and is a prerequisite for the Vis International Moot Course (Law 127).

(N.2) This course will not open for registration on June 19. Students ranked in the bottom quartile (25%) of the class at the start of their final year are required to take the course. Those students will be notified directly once Spring 2018 ranks have been determined. After that, the course will be open to a number of additional students who are in their final semester (or who are in their final year and cannot take the course in the spring). Additional information will be provided prior to the course opening for registration.

(N.3) Open to part-time students only through July 16, 2018, after which date the section opens to all students.

(N.4) This course will not meet weekly but will meet on assigned dates over the course of the semester as determined by the instructor.

(N.5) This is a seven week course, starting mid-semester. Enrollment is with permission of the instructor only.
