(N.1) This course will meet once prior to the add/drop deadline, on Monday, January 22, so students can have an overview of the course and an initial class meeting. The class will then resume on Wednesday, February 14, and meet every Monday and Wednesday for an hour and fifty minutes each time for the remainder of the semester. This course will meet for 2 hours at a time, even though it is a 3 credit course because it will meet 21 times over the course of the semester instead of 28.

(N.2) Information regarding the application process will be sent via LawNews email. The class meets for two hours a week but students receive three credits total given other assigned work and meetings outside of the regularly schedule classroom time.

(N.3) This course will meet for 2 hours at a time, even though it is a 3 credit course. It will meet 21 times over the course of the semester Instead of 28. Class dates to be announced in the syllabus.

(N.4) This course will meet offsite two Fridays a month at the U.S. Bankruptcy Court in Alexandria, Virginia, between 10:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. The first meeting date will be announced by the instructor.

(N.5) Students who have taken this course once may enroll in the course a second time because the assigned readings change semester to semester.

(N.6) Students ranked in the bottom quartile (25%) of the class at the start of their final year are required to take this course pursuant to AR 3-3.2(d). Students required to take the course will be notified via email in advance of registration. The course will also be open to additional students who are in their final semester on a first come, first serve basis, at a date to be announced via LawNews email.

(N.7) This course meets for two hours but students earn three credits because of Clinic work performed outside the regularly scheduled class time. Information regarding the M-VETS application process was sent via Law News email.

(N.8) This course will not meet every week, but will instead meet 3-4 times over the semester. Students who took this course in Fall 2017 are eligible to register for the course in Spring 2018 because the assigned readings are different each semester.

(N.9) Applications will be accepted via Symplicity. Application information will be sent out via LawNews email. Additional information about the externship programs is available on the CAS website.

(N.10) Students NOT being compensated for the work performed during their externship should register for this course.

(N.11) Students being compensated for the work performed during their externship should register for this course. Students are limited to a maximum of six credit hours of compensated externship credit.
