(N.1) Antitrust II will meet for 2 hours at a time, although it is a 3 credit course. It will meet 20 times over the course of the semester instead of 26 times. Class dates to be announced in the syllabus.

(N.2) The Arts & Entertainment Clinic meets for two hours a week but students receive three credits total given other assigned work and meetings outside of the regularly scheduled classroom time. Information regarding the application process has been sent via LawNews email.

(N.3) The Bankruptcy Externship program will meet offsite on the 2nd and 4th Friday of the month between 10:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. at the U.S. Bankruptcy Court, 200 South Washington St., Alexandria, Virginia. The first meeting date will be announced by the instructor.

(N.4) Business Associations is a 4-credit course that will meet for 2 hours and 10 minutes each class session because the instructor anticipates the need to take 1 week of parental leave during the course of the semester. The specific dates that the class will not meet will be announced.

(N.5) The Immigration Litigation Clinic meets for two hours a week but students receive four credits total given other assigned work and meetings outside of the regularly scheduled classroom time.

(N.6) The Innovation Law Clinic meets for two hours a week but students receive three credits total given other assigned work and meetings outside of the regularly scheduled classroom time. Information regarding the application process has been sent via LawNews email.

(N.7) Students who have taken the Law & Economics Colloquium once may enroll a second time because the assigned readings change semester to semester.

(N.8) Students ranked in the bottom quartile (25%) of the class at the start of their final year are required to take Legal Fundamentals in order to graduate pursuant to AR 3-3.2(d). Students required to take the course will be notified via email in advance of registration. The course will also be open to additional students who are in their final semester on a first come, first served basis, at a date announced via LawNews email.

(N.9) The M-VETS Clinic meets for two hours but students earn four credits because of work performed outside the regularly scheduled class time. Information regarding the application process has been sent via LawNews.

(N.10) The Mental Illness Law Clinic meets for two hours a week but students receive three credits total because of work performed outside of the regularly scheduled classroom time, including attending civil commitment hearings at local hospitals. See Clinic Information Packet and course syllabus for more detail.

(N.11) Readings in Legal Thought will not meet every week, but on assigned dates over the course of the semester as determined by the instructor. Students who took this course in Fall 2019 are eligible to register for the course in Spring 2020 because the assigned readings are different each semester.

(N.12) Students must receive approval to register for any Supervised Externship program and should submit the Externship Information Form found in the Externship module on Symplicity to begin the process. (Virginia Practice Externship applicants will submit the form after meeting with Professor Davis and Ilissa Belanger.) To access the form, log into Symplicity and select Externship Module from the "Shortcuts" on the right side of the screen. Once approved, students will be registered by the Records Office for the appropriate externship course. Students NOT being compensated for the work being performed during their externship will be registered for Law 179, 320, 321, or 325. Students being compensated for the work being performed during their externship will be registered for Law 520, 521, 525, or 579. Students are limited to a maximum of 6 credit hours of compensated externship and such credit may be earned only in a student's final two full semesters (fall or spring). Further details regarding externship requirements can be found on the Clinics & Externships page on the law school website.
