Parking Instructions for Friday, August 14 & Saturday, August 15, 2009

View a map of the campus at: <u>http://www.law.gmu.edu/geninfo/directions</u> (scroll to bottom of page). The law school building is called Hazel Hall.

The Best Option for Attendance is Metro!

If you decide to come by Metro, take the Orange Line to the Virginia Square/GMU Metro stop. Exit the station and make a 180 degree turn, so you will be facing Fairfax Drive. Cross the street and walk right down the sidewalk, toward the FDIC Building. The School of Law, Hazel Hall, which is just past the big construction site, is located in the white building on the corner of Fairfax Drive and Kirkwood Road.

If Arriving By Car, You Have Three Options.

(1.) As your *FIRST CHOICE*, you should park on the surface lot of the Truland building *or* in the garage under the Truland building located at 3330 N. Washington Blvd.

The Truland building is an all black, glass building which sits directly behind the law school on the corner of Washington Boulevard and Kirkwood Street.

To park in either location you will need to download and print the attached pass. The pass must be placed on your car's dashboard at all times.

To enter the surface lot of the Truland Building: If you are coming from Fairfax Drive and I-66, you can make a left at Quincy Street (the Arlington Funeral Home sign is on the corner) and then make a right onto Washington Boulevard across from Washington and Lee High School. Once you get to the light at the intersection of Washington Boulevard and Kirkwood, make a right on Kirkwood. The surface lot access is the first driveway on the right off Kirkwood. Park in the spots that are marked as reserved for GMU.

To enter the garage underneath the Truland Building: If you are coming from Fairfax Drive and I-66, you can make a left at Quincy Street (the Arlington Funeral Home sign is on the corner) and then make a right onto Washington Boulevard across from Washington and Lee High School. Pass the Giant on your right. As you drive down the street, you will see the all black building on the right. That is the Truland building. Enter the garage underneath the building. It will be on your right just before the light at the corner of Washington Boulevard and Kirkwood Street. If you get to Kirkwood, you have gone too far. Park in the spaces that are marked reserved for GMU.

(2.) A SECOND OPTION is provided by the retail parking section of the garage under the Foundation building, the large white building next to the Truland Building on Washington Blvd.

To park in this location you will need to download and print the attached pass. The pass must be placed on your car's dashboard at all times.

To enter the garage of the Foundation Building, it is recommended that you approach the garage from the north on Washington Blvd. so you can make a right turn into the garage entrance. If you are driving on Fairfax Drive from I-66, you can make a left at Quincy St. (the Arlington Funeral Home sign is on the corner) and then make a right onto Washington Boulevard, across from Washington and Lee High School. The entrance to the garage is just past the Giant loading dock, and you enter by turning right at the traffic light that is just past the Giant parking lot, at its loading dock.

For Friday Only:

Display the Parking Pass on your dashboard.

Take a Ticket (the Original Ticket) as you enter the garage. Retain the Original Ticket for exit from the garage.

When you are in the law school building, please see the greeters at the registration table to obtain a Second Ticket, which is a validation of the Original Ticket. When you exit the garage on Friday, you will insert the Original Ticket in the machine first. Then insert the Second Ticket, and you will be able to exit without charge.

For Saturday Only:

Display the Parking Pass on your dashboard. The attendant will recognize the Pass, and you will not be required to follow the Ticket procedures detailed above.

(3.) The THIRD OPTION is provided by the many metered spots around the law school building, most of which accept credit card payment. You must pay up until 6 p.m.

Remember: After the 14th and 15th of August, you will need to purchase a parking pass for the Arlington Campus. Parking passes allow you to park in the Foundation Garage for the semester.

Note: Do not park in handicap spaces – you will be ticketed.
