

Examination Rules

- Sit in a seat marked with a colored dot & display your Room Assignment Card on your desk.
- Food and drink are allowed if they are on the desk prior to the exam start.
- Earplugs are allowed if they are non-wired and non-electronic.
- All personal items not explicitly permitted in the exam instructions, including bags and backpacks, should be at the front or side of the room. This includes all cell phones and electronic devices (including watches or other wireless/internet connected devices), which should be turned off or in silent mode.
- Second monitors are NOT allowed unless a student has an accommodation letter allowing for such use.
- You may leave the exam room, but cannot discuss the exam with anyone.
- The use of cell phones and electronic devices (including watches or other wireless/internet connected devices) is prohibited anywhere in the building while you are taking an exam – except laptops, as permitted for the exam.
- Keep exams face-down until you are told to begin.
- Put your 6-digit Exam Number on all of your exam materials (exam booklet, scrap paper, etc.).
- Cutting and pasting text is permitted within an exam answer. However, cutting and pasting text from computer files or the Internet into an exam answer is NOT permitted and is an Honor Code Violation.
- The use of Generative Artificial Intelligence (GAI) in preparing to write or writing exam answers is PROHIBITED unless your professor provides written exam instructions allowing its usage. Using GAI is an Honor Code violation unless it is expressly permitted in the exam instructions.
- Return all exam materials (anything provided to you at the start of the exam, including your Room Assignment Card, scrap paper, exam booklet, etc.) to the Record Office at the end of the exam.
- DO NOT publicly discuss or post on social media anything regarding exam content until after the end of the exam make-up period because some students have delayed exams.
